41.	<u>Apologies for Absence and to consider the reasons given</u> Apologies were received from Councillor Slade who had a previous engagement and Councillor Mackay who was unwell. Resolved: To accept the apologies for the reasons given.

43.	<u>Minutes</u> Resolved: That the minutes of the Planning Committee held on Wednesday 14 th November 2018 be signed and adopted as a correct record.
44.	<u>Planning Applications for Consideration</u> The Committee considered a schedule of applications for planning consent that had been submitted for consultation by the local planning authority. Resolved: That the Local Planning Authority be advised of the observations of the Committee on the submitted applications as below: a. 18/04958/OUT (18/19/63) Somerset & Dorset Railway Heritage Trust, Midsomer Norton South Railway Station, Silver Street, MSN BA3 2EY.

	<p>Outline application with all matters reserved for extension to existing maintenance shed to provide flexible events space, cafe and dining space, space for artisans, microbrewery and lecture/meeting space. 10 new mixed used units for retail Class A1, A3 cafes and bars, Class B1(a), Class B1(c) and Class D1 assembly for education and training support space. 3 tourist accommodation units. Carriage/maintenance shed with associated sidings access and boiler workshop. New WC facilities, improvements to open space and landscaping, removal of vehicle access and creation of improved pedestrian environment.</p> <p>Comment</p> <p><i>Councillor Myers joined the meeting at 7.18pm</i></p> <p><i>Councillor Myers abstained from the vote.</i></p> <p>The Committee acknowledged the energy and commitment of the applicants and felt that their vision of a thriving and self-sufficient railway heritage site would, if realised, be very positive for the town. However, on the current application they found they had to agree with BANES Highways comments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safe, adequate and appropriate means of access to the site for all users needs to be demonstrated • No evidence had been supplied to show how potential conflicts arising from increased demand of traffic would be dealt with • The parking facilities as planned would not accommodate the likely demand. <p>It was considered that the proposal in its current form represented an overdevelopment of the site and would potentially detract from its function as a heritage site. The committee hoped that the applicants would engage at an earlier stage with the town council and other interested local parties if they considered further applications.</p> <p>b. 18/05353/FUL (18/19/64) Mr David Millington, 17 Bluebell Rise, MSN BA3 2RR. Erection of front porch.</p> <p>No Objection</p>

<p>48.</p>	<p><u>Proposed Works to Trees</u></p> <p>The Committee considered the following Application for proposed Tree Works that had been submitted for consultation by the local planning authority.</p> <p>Resolved: That the Local Planning Authority be advised of the observations of the Committee on the submitted applications as below:</p> <p>a. 18/05142/TCA I S Property Developments Ltd, 59 High Street, MSN BA3 2DQ. Stone Pine (T1) – fell.</p> <p>Object</p> <p>The removal of the Stone Pine would affect the visual amenity of the Town from higher areas.</p> <p>b. 18/05271/TCA Owner/Occupier, 101 Radstock Road, MSN BA3 2AU. T1 Cherry - Reduction of canopy by 1m from extremities back to live growth points. Balance crown, remove major deadwood and prevent interference with overhead services. T2 Apple - Remove deadwood and lift crown to a consistent line. Rebalance and reduce canopy spread. Prune back from extremities by a maximum of 2m to live growth points.</p> <p>No Objection</p>
