Four community groups are to be supported by Grants after their applications were approved by Midsomer Norton Town Council at its meeting on Monday 1st September.

Off the Record, Norton Radstock Swimming Club, Midsomer Norton and District Twinning Association and Charlton Play Area Project submitted applications for Grants. All were successful in their applications for support and the Council recognised the wide variety of community benefits that their applications would bring. In considering the four applications, the Town Council recommended a total of over £6,000 be awarded based on its Grant policy to support organisations that can benefit the town and its residents.

“We are always keen to support the work of local community groups and our Grant programme enables us to provide financial assistance where it will make a real difference” said Cllr Brian Lawrence who chairs the Council’s Finance Working Party which provides the Council with advice on Grant applications and policy. “This round of applications reflects the diversity of our community groups and we hope that others will take the opportunity to approach us for support in the coming rounds of Grants later in the year”.
