The Wunderbar

Following an approach from one of the licensees, the licence conditions of the Wunderbar were discussed by Midsomer Norton Town Council at its meeting on Monday 1st September. In discussing a proposal made by Cllr Linda Dunford, the Council recognised the importance of balancing the need to ensure that the licensing objectives are met and the viability of this small venue.

The Council recognised that the venue is an important part of the diverse night life on offer in Midsomer Norton and after carefully considering the proposed variations put forward by the licensee, it voted to offer to support the licensees if they make an application to Bath and North East Somerset – the Licensing Authority.

“Following an approach from one of the licensees, the Town Council is pleased to have the opportunity to offer its support to a licence variation application to Bath and North East Somerset Council. The Town Council recognises the strenuous efforts of the licensees to meet the licensing objectives in recent months and is confident that these will continue going forward. The Council will support the proposed application on this basis” said Cllr Dunford after the meeting.

The Council will now wait for the application to be submitted to Bath and North East Somerset Council before submitting its views to the Licensing Authority.
