

The Garden of Friendship

The Garden of Friendship is now near completion with benches and a bin to be installed within the coming weeks.

Midsomer Norton Town Council have placed an order for 3 sturdy benches to finish off the Garden and make it a green space for the community to enjoy.

With the telephone box as a feature, which the Town Council adopted from BT and arranged for it to be refurbished by professional restorers Remember When, the Garden will be a place to relish. The Council have been working with the Royal Institute of British Architects to produce copies of the original plans for the church and Scott's designs for the K6 kiosk. These will be displayed in the telephone box for all to admire.

The south boundary has now been renovated with a border and a new palisade fence screened by a beech hedge following the granting of planning permission.

The final piece of the initial project saw a bespoke pair of gates under an arch designating the site as The Garden of Friendship installed.

The space has already been used by community groups for events as it offers a perfect spot for children's games or activities, garden parties or any outside activity close to the town centre.
